#### **Responsibilities:**

##### **1. Continuous Monitoring & Surveillance of Campus Areas**

The Squad performs **surprise checks and routine patrols** across:

- Classrooms
- Hostels
- Library
- Hospital departments
- Herbal garden
- Common areas

This aligns with the document's requirement for *regular monitoring & supervision of campus facilities*.

##### **2. Immediate Response to Ragging-Related Incidents**

The Squad acts as the **first responder** for any complaint, distress call, or observed misconduct.

This is drawn from the institution's responsibility for quick grievance handling and student safety.

##### **3. Enforcing Discipline & Student Behaviour Norms**

The Squad ensures students follow the expected code of conduct by actively preventing:

- Harassment
- Intimidation
- Misbehaviour

This aligns with the document's emphasis on **student discipline, behaviour monitoring, and compliance**.

##### **4. Identifying and Reporting High-Risk Areas**

The Squad must flag any area where ragging is more likely to occur and recommend preventive steps.

This comes under campus oversight and supervision responsibilities.

##### **5. Recording Observations & Submitting Reports**

Maintaining daily/weekly records of:



- Surveillance rounds
- Incidents observed
- Interactions with students
- Recommendations to the Anti-Ragging Committee

This is based on the document's strong emphasis on **records, documentation, and reporting** for compliance.

#### 6. Coordinating With Student Support & Grievance Cells

The Squad must immediately inform the:

- Anti-Ragging Committee
  - Student Support Committee
  - Grievance Redressal Committee
- about any case or suspicion of ragging.

#### 7. Assistance During Orientation & Awareness Drives

Assist the Anti-Ragging Committee in educating freshers and parents.

This corresponds to institutional responsibility for *orientation, student support, and sensitization*.

#### 8. Immediate Escalation During Emergencies

If a student is harmed or threatened, the Squad must coordinate with:

- Hospital Administration
- Emergency & Disaster Committee

This links to the hospital/emergency coordination roles in the document.

- They **report**
- They **prevent ragging proactively**

#### **Responsibilities:**

- The committee must maintain a safe and disciplined academic environment, ensuring that the institution provides a **supportive environment for learning** and student well-being.
- Monitor student behaviour, adherence to institutional code of conduct, and prevent any activities that may cause physical or psychological harm.  
Student behaviour, mentoring, support, and grievance resolution are part of institutional responsibilities.
- Ensure regular supervision of **hostels, classrooms, hospital areas, herbal garden, library, and common spaces** to prevent incidents of harassment or intimidation.  
This aligns with the document's requirement for monitoring and supervision committees.
- Respond quickly to any complaints received from students, parents, or stakeholders.  
The document mandates robust grievance handling mechanisms and student support systems.
- Coordinate with Student Support Committee and Feedback Committee to understand students' concerns, mental well-being, and safety-related issues.  
Feedback from students forms a core part of the monitoring process.
- Conduct awareness programs, meetings, and sensitization sessions to educate students about the **legal and institutional consequences** of ragging. This comes under the institutional responsibility to conduct training and orientation as mentioned throughout the document.
- Maintain records of:**
  - Anti-ragging undertakings
  - Meetings conducted
  - Complaints received
  - Actions taken

The document emphasizes proper documentation and record-keeping for all committees.



8. Ensure the campus follows **NCISM, AYUSH & UGC anti-ragging regulations** by integrating them into the institutional compliance framework.  
Overall academic and administrative compliance is mandated in the document.
9. If ragging causes physical or psychological harm, the Anti-Ragging Committee must coordinate with:
  - Hospital Administration
  - Emergency Response Committee
10. Provide counselling, protection, and necessary support to affected students through the Student Support and Mentoring system.
