Responsibilities:

- The **Institutional Innovation Committee** shall identify or invite innovative ideas from students, teachers, and staff of the institute and facilitate incubation or nurturing of ideas to translate them into useful products or outcomes. Innovations may include but are not limited to:
 - Teaching methodologies
 - Dosage forms and drug delivery systems
 - Diagnostic tools
 - Software and applications
 - Therapeutic and surgical equipment
 - Assessment scales and related innovations
- A faculty member familiar with research, publication, and Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) or one who has undergone training conducted by the Commission shall be appointed as the coordinator. If the appointed Coordinator has not undergone such training, they must complete it within six months.
- The Institute shall develop a comprehensive **Institutional Policy** to support activities related to:
 - Innovation
 - Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)
 - Incubation
 - Disbursement of research grants
 - Research and publications
 - Research and publication incentives
- The **Institutional Policy** shall be oriented towards all stakeholders and shall have a structured **implementation and monitoring mechanism** to ensure effectiveness.
