Gather structured feedback related to:

- Learning resources
- Hospital exposure
- Internship support
- Hostel facilities

Then submit it to the Stakeholder Feedback Committee.

(Directly linked with feedback requirements.)

3. Support Student Behaviour, Discipline & Conduct Norms

Assist the institution by promoting:

- Discipline
- Ethical behaviour
- Professionalism
- Anti-ragging awareness

These fall under the “student behaviour monitoring” responsibilities.

4. Organise and Coordinate Student Activities

Help implement academic, cultural, sports, and wellness activities that contribute to:

- Student development
- Healthy campus environment

This aligns with student support & learning enrichment requirements.

5. Assist in Mentoring and Peer-Support Initiatives

The Student Council helps the mentoring system by:

- Supporting junior students
- Assisting in orientation programs
- Guiding students in academic or behavioural issues

(Matched with mentoring & support system duties.)

6. Promote Awareness on Institutional Policies

Educate students on:

- Anti-ragging policies
- Code of conduct
- ISA/UEQ academic policies

- Internship rules
- Hospital discipline

these awareness duties are part of the institutional support structure.

7. Help in Grievance Identification & Escalation

Observe issues faced by students and escalate them to:

- Grievance Redressal Cell
- Student Support Committee
- Principal

This is parallel to the grievance process described in the document.

8. Assist During Campus Monitoring & Supervision

Coordinate with committees to ensure:

- Cleanliness
- Safety
- Discipline
- Proper use of teaching/hospital facilities

This reflects the “monitoring & supervision” responsibilities throughout the guidelines.

9. Participate in Institutional Committees (as Student Representatives)

Provide representation in committees such as:

- Academic Leadership Group
- Feedback Committee
- IQAC/IQU
- Grievance Committee
- Anti-ragging


(The document requires stakeholder – including student – participation.)
